The Problems

Simple itching caused by fleas can be irritating enough for a dog or cat, but fleas can cause more serious health problems too. Fleas are responsible for transmitting tapeworm to cats, dogs and even humans, whilst also spreading bacterial diseases. Some pets develop severe allergies to flea bites which may last long after the fleas have gone.

Signs of fleas include irregular scratching and biting by pets or spotting the 2mm-long insects in their coat. Tiny black droppings might also be seen on the pet's skin, carpets, pet bedding or other furnishings.



The Solutions

Although fleas lay their eggs amongst the fur of animals, these easily fall off and become embedded in carpets and rugs. Flea larvae burrow deep into fabrics, bedding and carpets so off-pet solutions such as the ZERO24 Home Flea Powder, ZERO27 Natural Insect Killer Flea Bomb, and ZERO25 Home Flea Spray are extremely important to stop a flea infestation.

Rid pet fur of fleas by combing them regularly with the ZERO23 Flea Killer Comb; small electrical charges will kill fleas that come into contact with the teeth without causing any harm to pets.



Prevention

Regular vacuuming and washing of pet bedding are recommended to prevent further flea habitation. Flea eggs are almost impossible to see with the naked eye so monitor for flea activity with the ZERO20 Flea Killer. Begin treatment of the surrounding area and pets if the sticky pads are trapping fleas.

Check pets frequently with the Flea Killer Comb to avoid the transference of fleas from wildlife when the pet has been outdoors. When it comes to fleas, the faster you get rid of them, the better!



Flea Facts

- There are over 2,000 species of flea in the world and are a common problem almost everywhere.
- When a flea jumps onto a pet, it will start feeding within 5 minutes and can live on them for almost 2 months.
- A flea can jump up to 8 inches high but rarely from pet to pet; most flea infestations come from newly developed fleas from the pet's environment.
- It's not just cats and dogs that can carry fleas, but rats, rabbits, foxes, squirrels and mice can too.
- Huge numbers of adult fleas can remain dormant inside pupae for weeks and months, waiting for the right conditions to infest animals and pets.
- Fleas can lay up between 40-50 eggs a day and up to 2,000 in their lifetime.
